

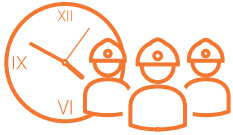

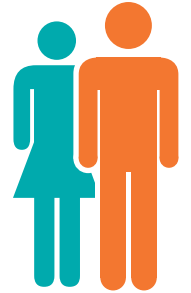

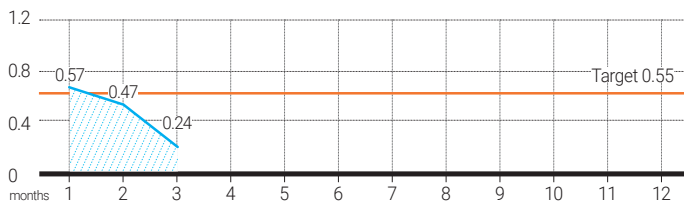

Oyu Tolgoi's workforce was 97% Mongolian at the end of the first quarter of 2022 with 49.4% of our total workforce working on the Underground Project.

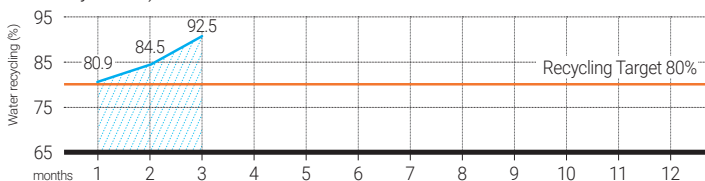
WATER USE EFFICIENCY

WATER RECYCLING RATE

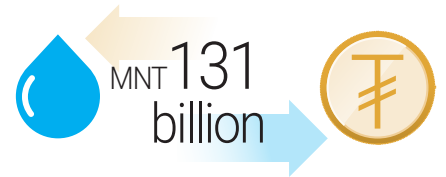
(Per cent by month)

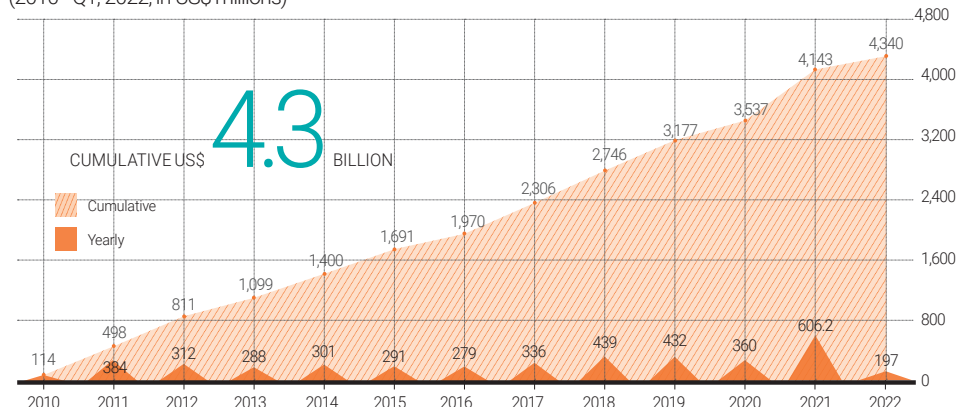
Since 2013, **1,210** students have participated in the programme.

(2010 - Q1, 2022, in US\$ millions)

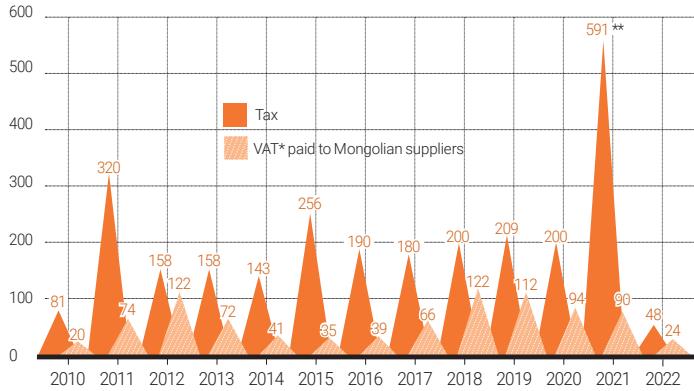


Oyu Tolgoi operations procurement team collaborated with 577 suppliers in the first quarter of 2022, of which 409 are national businesses representing 76% of total operations procurement spend. Since 2010, Oyu Tolgoi has spent US\$4.3 billion on national procurement.

Since 2010, Oyu Tolgoi has paid US\$3.65 billion in taxes, fees and other payments, including the VAT paid to Mongolian suppliers. In the first quarter of 2022, Oyu Tolgoi paid US\$72 million in the form of taxes, fees and other payments to the Government of Mongolia.

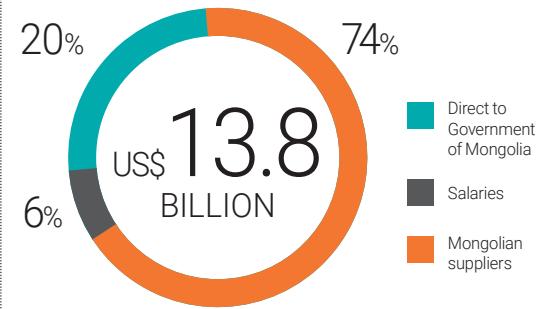

TOTAL IN-COUNTRY SPEND

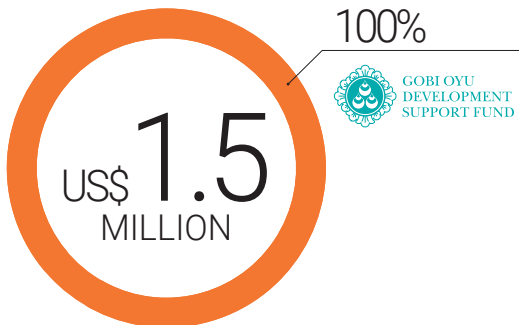

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN UMNUGOVI PROVINCE

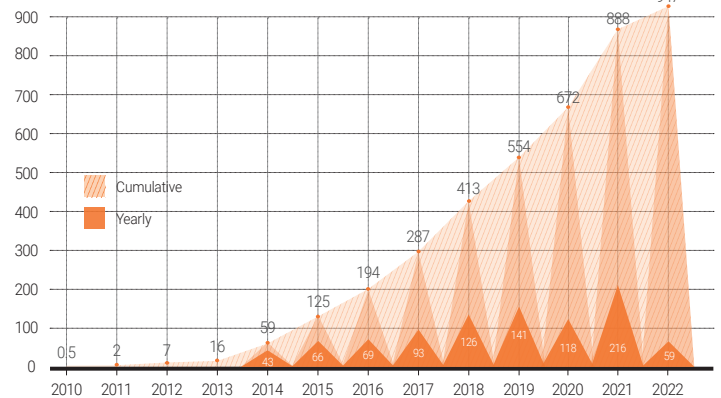
(in US\$ millions)

LOCAL PROCUREMENT (UMNUGOVI PROVINCE)

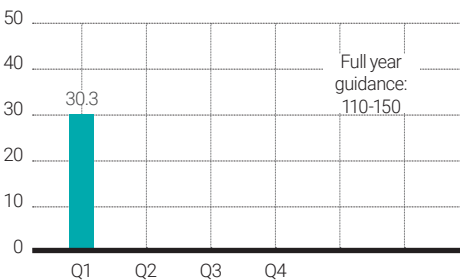

PRODUCTION OF COPPER IN CONCENTRATE

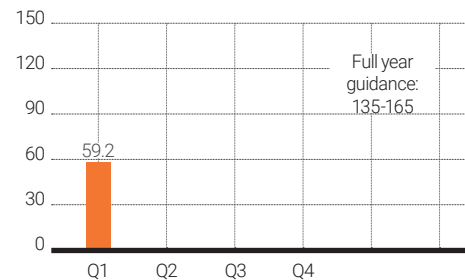
('000 tonnes)

PRODUCTION OF GOLD IN CONCENTRATE

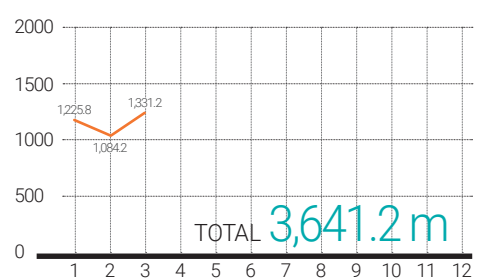
('000 ounces)
